Mate Crime might be something that the police would get involved in.

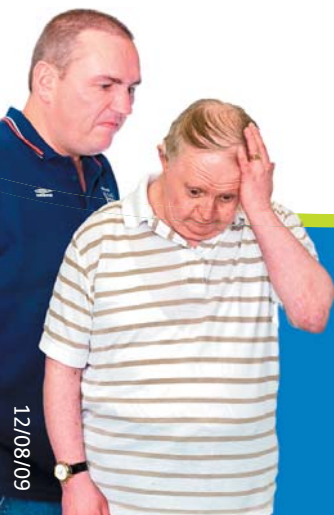
